

ALLAN SCOTT MARLBOROUGH PINOT GRIS 2018

Marlborough Pinot Gris has grown strongly in popularity over the last few years, and has quickly become a staple in the Allan Scott Family Winemakers range.

VITICULTURE

2018 was a season of extremes, from virtual drought and some of the hottest days on record, to record rainfall for January, ending with a southerly blast and snow in April. Fortunately, we had the ability to call on Allan Scott and his 44yrs of growing grapes and making wine in Marlborough. Careful planning and meticulous attention in the vineyard kept our grapes free from disease pressure. We've been pleased with the quality of good, evenly ripened fruit with solid brix numbers across the varieties.

WINEMAKING

This fruit was machine harvested to break up the grapes and to help with maximum extraction from the fruit. The juice was then cool fermented to retain fruit characters before being conditioned prior to bottling.

DESCRIPTION

This Pinot Gris had a short spell of skin contact to enhance colour and flavour. With aromas of melon, citrus and stone fruit, this wine is highly drinkable now and will accompany a broad range of cuisine.

SERVING SUGGESTION

Serve this wine as an aperitif with a platter of hard cheeses, with fish, or stone fruit desserts. Enjoy lightly chilled.
